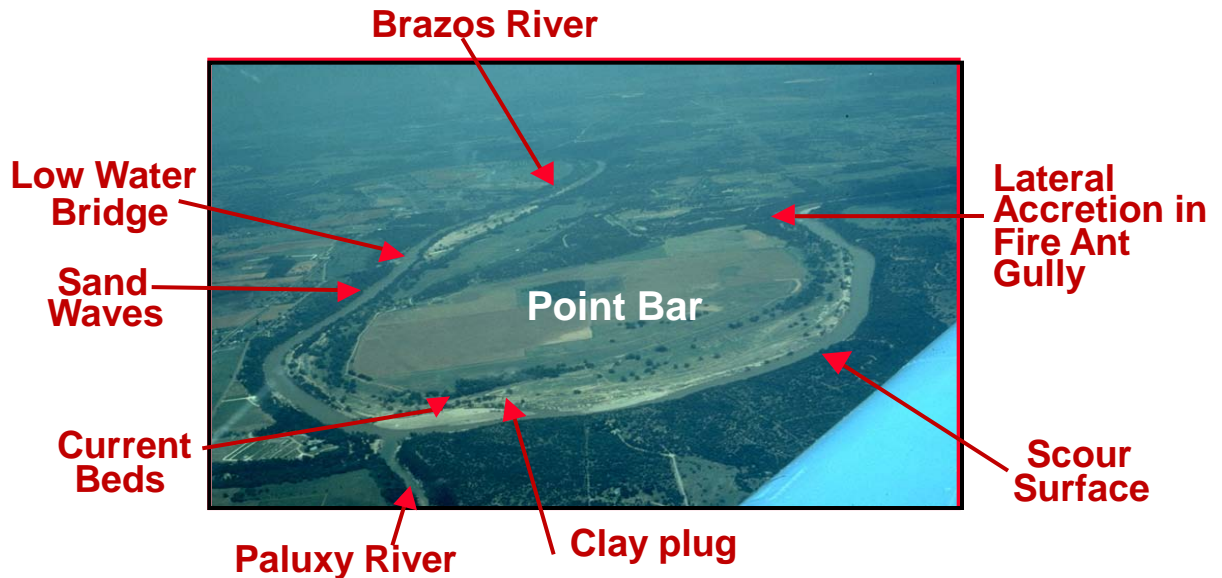


BRAZOS RIVER FLUVIAL SEMINAR
